The post office at Baclieu opened in 1884. Its first known postmark was a type E2 device. Baclieu 's type E2 postmark remained in use for nearly three decades at the turn of the century.

### BADONG COCHINCHINE

Although the Badong post office opened in 1899, its earliest known postmark is the type E2 device from a decade later. This postmark remained in service for over two decades.

## BAKE COCHINCHINE

The secondary post office at Bake began operations in 1882 and was transferred to Tambinh on 6 November 1918. Bake's only postmark was a type E2 and this is the earliest recorded example.

### BATRI COCHINCHINE

The first postmark to use the "BATRI" spelling instead of the "BAOTRI" spelling was a type E2 device in 1907. It was to remain in service for over two decades. This is the earliest known example of Batri's type E2 postmark.

# BENCAT COCHINCHINE

Bencat's secondary post office eventually became a rural post office. Bencat's final postmark was a type G device. Here the postmark was struck with blue ink.



#### BENTRE SUD VIETNAM

When the political instabilities following World War II gave rise to new designations for the various territorial regions of Indochina, the Bentre post office put into service in 1949 postmarks that identified Bentre as part of "SUD VIET-NAM." This is the earliest known example of Bentre's type V1 postmark.
