Soctrang's type W2 postmark appeared in 1952, the same year that Indochinese stamps were withdrawn from service. Franked with a mixture of Indochinese and Vietnamese stamps, the postal clerk who handled this mailing only canceled the Vietnamese stamps. The Indochinese stamps were left untouched since they contributed nothing to the postage as they had been made invalid for postage effective 1 April 1952.
