

Hue General Duty Stamps

In 1802, Emperor Gia Long founded the Nguyen dynasty, moved the capital from Hanoi to Hue in an effort to unite northern and southern Vietnam. Although Hue remained the royal capital, the French occupiers established their administrative capitals at Hanoi and Saigon.
