A small size envelope with a 5-centime denomination could be used to send calling cards qualified for a reduced rate if left unsealed.

This example posted from Cholon on the last day of 1894, a popular day for sending New Year's greetings, received a transit backstamp on the first day of 1895.







Letter cards were issued in two versions: a 15-centime denomination for local use and a 25-centime denomination for external use.










Commerce Lettercards Display Sample of 15 centimes

At the officially sanctioned exchange rate of 1 Indochinese piaster per 5 French francs, a 15-centime lettercard would cost 3 cents in the local currency. This sample was displayed in the Saigon post office to visually demonstrate this relationship to the public.







Commerce Stationery Use of 1-centime Wrapper

A 1-centime wrapper was used for a local mailing within Saigon in 1904. A large "T" signified that the postage was inadequate and a due amount was required from the recipient. The amount due of 5 centimes was indicated with a single copy of Indochina's first postage due stamp, which bears the same postmark as the one on the wrapper's indicium.






